



Shorewood Boosters 2022 Scholarship Application

The Shorewood High School Boosters are a non-profit organization run by parent volunteers and dedicated to financially supporting all of the clubs and teams at Shorewood and promoting school spirit. The scholarship program is designed to promote post-high school opportunities for Shorewood students.

Each year the Shorewood Boosters award money to graduating seniors through our scholarship program. The amount of money is determined by the Booster Scholarship committee. The award recipients are chosen by a group of independent judges. Do NOT include your name anywhere but on the front page of the application. The program is administered by a Boosters volunteer through the Shorewood counseling office.

General Information:

- Eligibility: All members of the graduating class of 2022 who are continuing in post-high school education and meet the criteria below are eligible.
- Scholarship Amount: One or more scholarships will be awarded to seniors graduating in the year 2022. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the Booster scholarship committee.
- Application Deadline: Application must be submitted to the Shorewood main office or electronically to president@shorewoodboosters.com by **2:30pm on Tuesday, May 10th, 2022.**
- Final Selections: An independent scholarship committee will determine the final selections.
- Award notification: Those chosen to receive a scholarship will be notified in early June.

Application Criteria:

1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 at the end of the first semester of senior year. (Verification will be done by the counseling office or Career Center.)
2. Provide a list of your extra-curricular and community activities during high school. Please outline the following information for each activity: Activity description, years participated, position(s) held, time commitment, advisor/mentor name.
3. Choose one of your activities and write an essay describing how your participation made a positive impact on your Shorewood experience. The essay should be one page, double spaced, 250 words or less.
4. All paperwork must be turned in to the front office at Shorewood or electronically to president@shorewoodboosters.com by 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday May 10th, 2022. This page must be included with your application and your name should **NOT** be on any other page.

Selection Criteria

- 50% School related extra-curricular activities and community involvement
- 50% Essay
